Venue: Due to the current situation generated by the SARS Covid-19 pandemic and bearing in mind both travelling restrictions and the health of our speakers and participants, this event will be held online.

Participants: EU officials, ministers, high-level political representatives of EUSDR members, National Coordinators, Priority Areas Coordinators, representatives of national, regional and local level administration, Employers and Trade Unions, representatives of SMEs, business support structures, industry, NGOs, academic institutions and other stakeholders from the Danube Region countries

Short description and format: The event will be organized with the support of the General Secretariat of the Government, technical support of the EUSDR National Coordinator Office from Romania, and of the project EXPERT of the Dunărea de Jos University of Galati. The 2020 Danube Cooperation Forum agenda will focus on the main measures suggested within the European Ecological Pact, a new strategy which will cover a number of policy areas, including climate, environment, energy, transport, industry, agriculture, as well as sustainable finance, all of them being strongly interconnected.

The forum proposes also a number of topics related to interconnectivity and regional mobility, smart cities and communities, quality management & good governance, security in the riverside regions of the Danube, environmental challenges as well as the links between smart specialization strategies, introduced in the European Union's Cohesion Policy as the basis for research and innovation investment. Last, but not least, the possibilities of creating synergies that can result in a better embedment of EUSDR into future EU programs and policies will be part of the agenda.
